If the non-resident violator failed to appear in court on the penalty assessment or failed to comply with payment arrangements, you must determine whether the violator resides in a participating compact state.

If the violator does not reside in one of the participating states no further action is necessary.

If the violator resides in a participating state, you must write the COURT CODE (SEE ATTACHED LIST) on the front and back of the citation (see sample). Fill in the proper amounts for fines applicable court costs and correction fees and write TOTAL AMOUNT DUE. Do not write above the area for "microfilm number."

The type of citations covered by the compact are moving traffic citations which themselves do not carry suspension or revocation. NRVC applies only to the penalty assessments indicated. The following citations are not covered by the compact:

- offenses which mandate personal appearance
- moving traffic violations which alone carry suspension or revocation penalties

- equipment violations
- inspection violations
- size and weight violations
- parking violations
- transportation of hazardous material violations

NRVC abstracts must be addressed and mailed separately to: Motor Vehicle Division, Penalty Assessment Unit, PO Box 1028, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504-1028, Attn: NRVC. Mail the abstracts to this address in a separate package from the flagging and rescind abstracts sent to the MVD. Please allow approximately twenty-five (25) days between the non-resident's failure to appear before mailing the abstracts to the Penalty Assessment Unit in the event the violator has mailed the payment in to your court.

If the home jurisdiction has taken more than six (6) months to act on a violation no further action is necessary (this includes our processing time).

As stated earlier, once the abstracts are sent to us, the non-resident will be requested to remit payment directly to the Motor Vehicle Division. If, however, the court should receive any money from a non-resident, the money should be kept and deposited.

Note: If you have accepted payment and had reported it as a non-payment, please notify the Division by completing FORM TMV 10947 - Rescission of Notice of Failure to Appear in Court. The Motor Vehicle Division will then clear the record and send the home state a compliance notice.

Monies collected for Magistrate Courts will be distributed to the Administrative Office of the Courts and they will re-imburse the court. Monies collected for Municipal Courts will be distributed directly to individual courts from which citations were received. A point out will sent to the court(s) indicating each individual cited and the total amount distributed to the court(s).

A printout will be received by the Court jurisdiction indicating each individual cited and the total amount distributed to the court.
